5	WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34173(g), the Successor
6 7	Agency to the Redevelopment Agency for the City of Colton ("Successor Agency") is a public entity, separate and distinct from the City of Colton; and
8	WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code section 34177 requires that the Successor
9	Agency prepare a "recognized obligation payment schedule" ("ROPS") listing outstanding enforceable obligations of the former Redevelopment Agency for the City of Colton
10 11	("Agency") to be performed by the Successor Agency, during the time period from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018 ("ROPS 17-18"); and
	WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code section 34177 requires the Successor Agency to
12 13	submit an electronic copy of the certified ROPS 17-18, as approved by the Successor Agency's Oversight Board ("Oversight Board"), to the State Controller, the County of San
14	Bernardino Auditor-Controller, and the State of California Department of Finance ("DOF") and post a copy of ROPS 17-18 on the Successor Agency's website; and
15 16	WHEREAS, the Successor Agency is required to submit an Oversight Board approved ROPS 17-18 to DOF no later than February 1, 2017; and
17 18	WHEREAS, Successor Agency staff prepared the ROPS 17-18 covering the time period from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, listing all of the outstanding enforceable obligations of the Agency for the period; and
19	WHEREAS on Lawrence 17, 2017, d. G.
20	<b>WHEREAS,</b> on January 17, 2017, the Successor Agency adopted Resolution No. SAR-01-17 approving ROPS 17-18; and
21	WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code sections 34177(m) and 34180(g) require that
22	the Oversight Board approve ROPS 17-18; and
23	WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code section 34177(o) allows DOF up to April 15, 2017 to review obligations listed on the Oversight Board approved ROPS 17-18;
24	2017 to review obligations listed on the Oversight Board approved ROFS 17-18,
25	NOW, THEREFORE, THE OVERSIGHT BOARD OF THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR THE CITY OF COLTON
26	DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AND FIND AS FOLLOWS:
27	Section 1. Recitals. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are

incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

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Section 2. CEQA Compliance. The approval of ROPS 17-18 through this Resolution does not commit the Oversight Board to any action that may have a significant effect on the environment. As a result, such action does not constitute a project subject to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act. The Secretary of the Oversight Board is authorized to file a Notice of Exemption under the California Environmental Quality Act with the appropriate official of the County of San Bernardino, California, within five (5) days following the date of adoption of this Resolution.

Section 3. Approval of ROPS 17-18. The Oversight Board hereby approves and adopts ROPS 17-18, in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 34177 and 34180.

Section 4. Transmittal of ROPS 17-18. The Oversight Board hereby authorizes and directs the Successor Agency to submit copies of ROPS 17-18 approved by the Oversight Board to the State of California Department of Finance, the State Controller's Office and the County of San Bernardino Auditor-Controller, prior to February 1, 2017, in accordance with Health and Safety Code section 34177 and other applicable law.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Resolution or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end, the provisions of this Resolution are severable. The Oversight Board declares that the Oversight Board would have adopted this Resolution irrespective of the invalidity of any particular portion of this Resolution.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Certification</u>. The Secretary of the Oversight Board shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.

Section 7. Effective Date. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34179(h), all actions taken by the Oversight Board may be reviewed by the State of California Department of Finance and, therefore, this Resolution shall become effective five (5) business days after the date of its adoption, except to the extent that a request for review of the actions taken in this Resolution is made by the State of California Department of Finance.
