Dear Mr. Vermillion and Ms. DeAngelis:

On May 17, 2012, the Rialto Successor Agency staff was notified by Todd Vermillion with the Department of Finance (DOF) that several items on Page 1 of the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule for July 1 to December 31, 2012 (ROPS2) were denied. In addition, other items on Page 2, 3 and 4 are still denied, as specified in a letter by DOF dated April 19, 2012 and as responded by the Successor Agency in a letter dated May 3, 2012. Attached is the revised copy of ROPS2 that was submitted on May 18, 2012 at the request of DOF.

On May 18, 2012, staff was notified by Todd Vermillion that several items on Page of 1 of the Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule for January 1 to June 30, 2012 (ROPS1) were also denied. In the DOF letter dated April 19, 2012, there was no mentioned of these items being denied. Attached is a revised copy of ROPS1 that was submitted on May 18, 2012 at the request of DOF.

The items that were denied on both ROPS1 and ROPS2 are as follows:

- Page 1: Items 8, 12 through 20, 23 and 25
- Page 2: Items 6 through 16, 19 and 20
- Page 3: Item 25
- Page 4: Items 8, 12, 15, 26, 27, 30.

The Successor Agency does not agree with the rejections by DOF but will resubmit at a later date items for reconsideration, in addition to the May 3rd letter, without waiving its rights with regard to the rejected items.
